



Thinking vegetable seeds?

Think **Terranova.**

Pak Choi White OP

Open Pollinated

- Thick pure white stems or petioles with smooth round leaves
- Suited to tropical conditions
- Easy and quick growing
- Matures 40 days after sowing
- Good for stir frying and soup
- Avoid planting early season in cool conditions to avoid bolting
- Brassica campestris: chinensis group.
