Our open pollinated onion seed varieties continue to form an important part of our onion variety assortment. KiwiGold, Terranova M&R Early and Applause are well know to the market.

The seed of these three ELK varieties is produced in a number of locations in NZ from bulbs selected and maintained by our experienced team here in NZ.

We aim to have quality seed consistently available to our customers.

Three years ago we embarked on a variety improvement project, working on these 3 varieties. We have engaged In-Depth Agronomy as consultants to assist with selections exhibiting early seedling vigour and improved marketable yield along with the important characteristics of bulb size, skin quality and storability.

Mercedes is an open pollinated PLK onion supplied by **Terranova Seeds Australia**. Seed is produced in Australia from seed bulbs selected and maintained by our Australian colleagues.

Our hybrid onion varieties are supplied from **Takii** of Japan. These varieties have the potential for very high yields of excellent quality bulbs. Characteristics include strong vigour and well developed root systems, making the varieties a good prospect for fields with marginal soils.

Hybrid

- Early maturing hybrid.
- Large globe shaped bulbs with high yield potential.
- Very strong seedling vigour with high establishment rates.
- Good skin quality and retention.
- Medium firm bulbs.
- Good management for downy mildew required.

- Long storage firm onion with excellent shipping potential.
- Uniform globe shape with good size uniformity ideal for the European market.
- Very good skin quality.
- Excellent pack-outs.
- Reliable performer over many years.





Mid season varieties

Applause

Open Pollinated

- Vigorous ELK type with strong plant growth and good foliar disease resistance.
- Very uniform in size and shape with the majority in "Medium" size grade 70-90mm.
- Very firm bulbs with excellent skin retention and storage potential.
- Strong against bolting.
- Maturity approximately 7 10 days later than KiwiGold.



M&R Early Improved

Open Pollinated

- Superior strain of the original NZ variety.
- Excellent storage potential.
- Excellent globe shaped bulbs.
- Early Intermediate maturity.







Late season varieties

Mercedes

Open Pollinated

- Mid-late Intermediate type.
- Originally selected as a refined M & R Regular type for Export.
- Uniform medium-large bulbs with tight necks.
- Excellent storage life.



Peloton

Hybrid

• Very uniform globe shaped bulbs with well filled necks.

TAKI

- Strong and vigorous root system.
- 3 to 4 skins with good retention.
- Firm bulbs with medium storage potential.
- Mid-season maturity similar to Rhinestone.
- Excellent yield potential.

- Very uniform, globe shaped bulbs with thin necks.
- Multiple dark brown skins with an attractive sheen.
- Strong roots and uniform top fall.
- Firm bulbs with intermediate storage potential.
- Excellent yield potential.



T400/Frontier

Hybrid

- Very uniform variety.
- High yields of large sized bulbs.
- Blocky globe shaped.
- Excellent skin quality. Dark skins
- Early long-day type, suitable for September sowing.
- Good storage potential.
